- 7. A recommendation letter from the class teacher from the previous school.
- 8. School leaving certificate.

- 3. Assessment book from previous school.
- 4. A recommendation letter from the Father in-charge.

Form 3 requirements for the interview:

- 1. Photocopy of K.N.E.C. K.C.P.E. Result slip.
- 2. Original and a photocopy of baptism card.
- 3. Results for Form 1 to 2: Term 1, 2 and 3.
- 4. One must be a Catholic, baptized and receiving Holy Communion.
- 5. A recommendation letter from the Father in-charge.
